

Dress Code

Proper dress is essential in class and performance rehearsals at BT-SLO. Proper dress allows the teacher or director to see the dancer's body and make corrections. Our dress code applies to every class and rehearsal.

General Dress Code

- Hair should be tied up neatly.
- Dangling or distracting jewelry, including watches, should be removed.

Ballet Class Dress Code

- Girls, Ladies
 - Leotard (solid color, minimal designs/embellishments)
 - Skirt (optional)
 - Tights (pink or black)
 - Hair in a bun
 - Ballet slippers
- Boys, Men
 - T-shirt
 - Leggings/sweat pants/dance pants/shorts
 - Dance belt
 - Ballet slippers
- **ADULTS IN ADULT BALLET 1 CLASS:** comfortable, close-fitting clothing is acceptable (tights & leotard are not required unless chosen by the dancer); ballet slippers are required.

Contemporary Class Dress Code

- Girls, Ladies
 - Leotard (solid color, minimal designs/embellishments) or t-shirt
 - Tights, leggings, dance pants, or sweatpants
 - Socks, jazz shoes, or ballet shoes are required (NO BARE FEET)
 - Hair tied back
- Boys, Men
 - T-shirt with leggings/dance pants/sweatpants/shorts
 - Dance belt
 - Socks, jazz shoes, or ballet shoes are required (NO BARE FEET)

Performance Rehearsal Dress Code

- Girls, Ladies & Boys, Men: same as Ballet Class Dress Code (including Adult 1 students)
